### for the First Lesson

Jonah reluctantly travels to Ninevah and warns the citizens of God's judgment. When they heed the warning and repent, God spares them.

### for the Second Lesson

Jesus begins his ministry, preaching that God's kingdom is near. Simon and his brother Andrew respond by leaving everything and following Jesus. Later James and his brother John do the same.
