### for the First Lesson

God speaks to Noah and his sons after they have left the ark and establishes the rainbow as a sign of his covenant. God will preserve the world, not destroy it.

### for the Second Lesson

Peter compares God's acting to save Noah from the flood to our salvation by baptism through Jesus' death and resurrection.

#### A reading from the First Letter of Peter (3:18-22)

Reader: *The word of the Lord.* Congregation: *Thanks be to God.*

### for the Gospel Lesson

Jesus is baptized by John in the Jordan River. Anointed by the Holy Spirit, Jesus hears a heavenly voice proclaim that he is God's beloved Son. He then departs to the wilderness for fasting and prayer.
