**Episcopal Diocese of Colorado:** Generation to Generation Capital Campaign for Cathedral Ridge. You may or may not have heard of this new \$5,000,000 campaign to renovate buildings and expand facilities. In 2010 the Diocese of Colorado was able to purchase the land and facilities that became known as The Center at Cathedral Ridge. Bishop O'Neill stated in his campaign letter that this is "our opportunity – not to build a "church camp" based on some idealized past, but to look forward with a new and renewed vision" He asks that "all of us . . . go "all in" with the heart of the next generation to create the "real goal of divine transformation of real hearts and lives, ours and others, for the sake of the kingdom where absolute love reigns absolutely, even here and now." The Bishop's Committee decided to present this to the congregation and have donations marked for Cathedral Ridge. At the Annual Meeting, the congregation in attendance will decide on the St. Luke's matching contribution.
